



- Poverty rate: 23.1%

- Has crime rate higher than 92% of all cities in New Jersey, per FBI crime data


Methods

- Collaborated with The Bridge to understand pilot group's unique needs












Topics covered: Body language, active listening, healthy communication

Validate the other



Conclusions and Recommendations



100% of participants learned something new after each session

100% of participants report that it is very likely they will practice the new information they learned from the series.

We conclude...

- Developing a culturally competent curriculum requires time, effort, group collaboration and interactions with members of the community
- Focus group provided valuable feedback for adjustments

In the future, we recommend...

- Continuing to use community focus groups for new programs
- Promoting workshops in local churches, libraries, and schools
- Considering a 2-part series or single, long workshop
- Continuing to provide incentives for each workshop
- Following up with pilot study participants
